Dear Parents and Guardians,

Pursuant to N.J.S.A 18A:7C-6.6, districts must provide parents and guardians certain information on any State or commercially developed standardized assessment that will be administered during the school year. Below, please find the Little Falls Public School testing information. Testing window covers the time it will take the entire district to complete the assessment. Each grade will have a specific testing time within that window. Please note that as the testing dates approach, you will receive more detailed information. This year, since there has not been standardized testing for two years, the Start Strong Assessments in the fall as well as the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) in the spring are required through the federal government.
