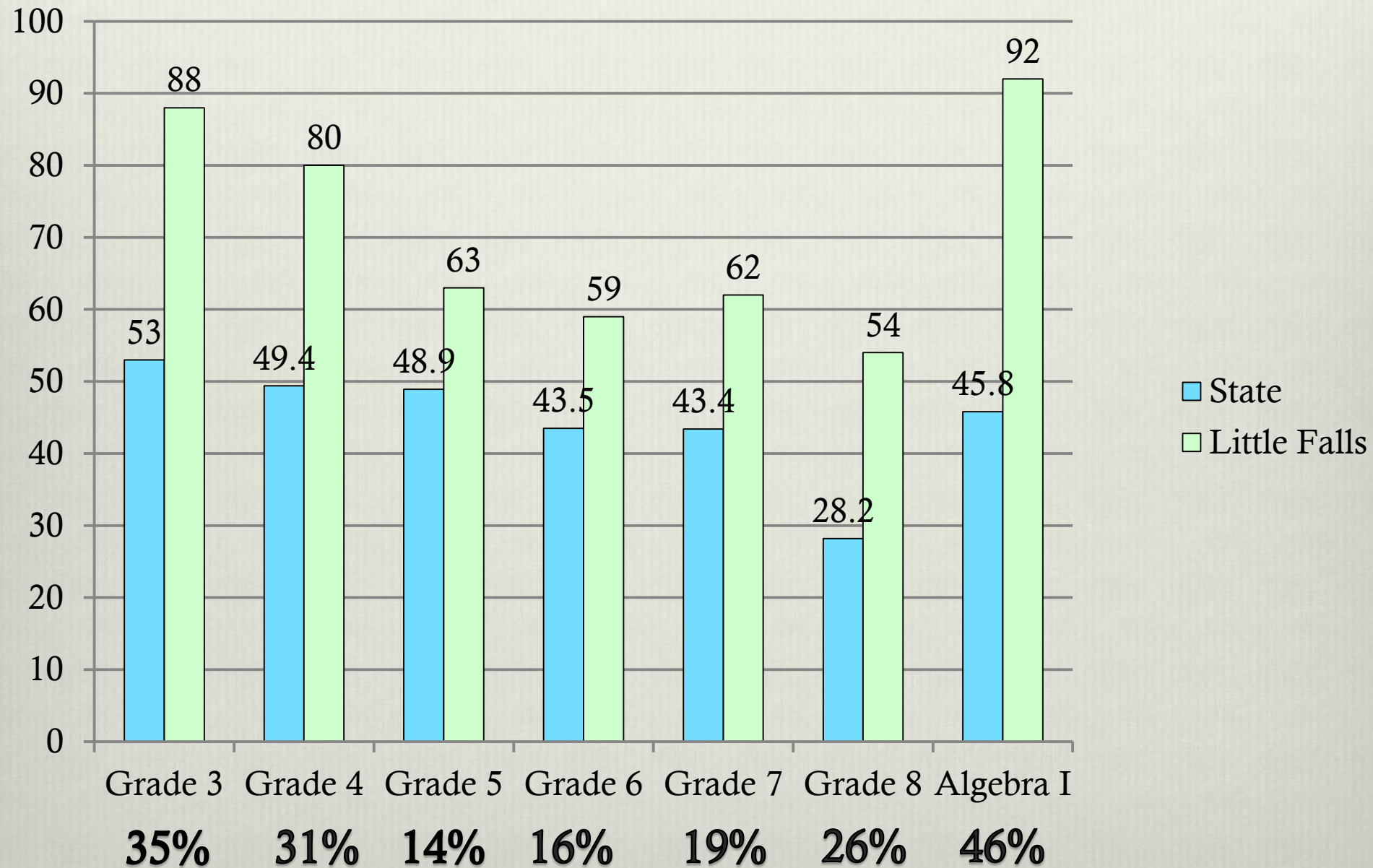

# Mathematics Comparison

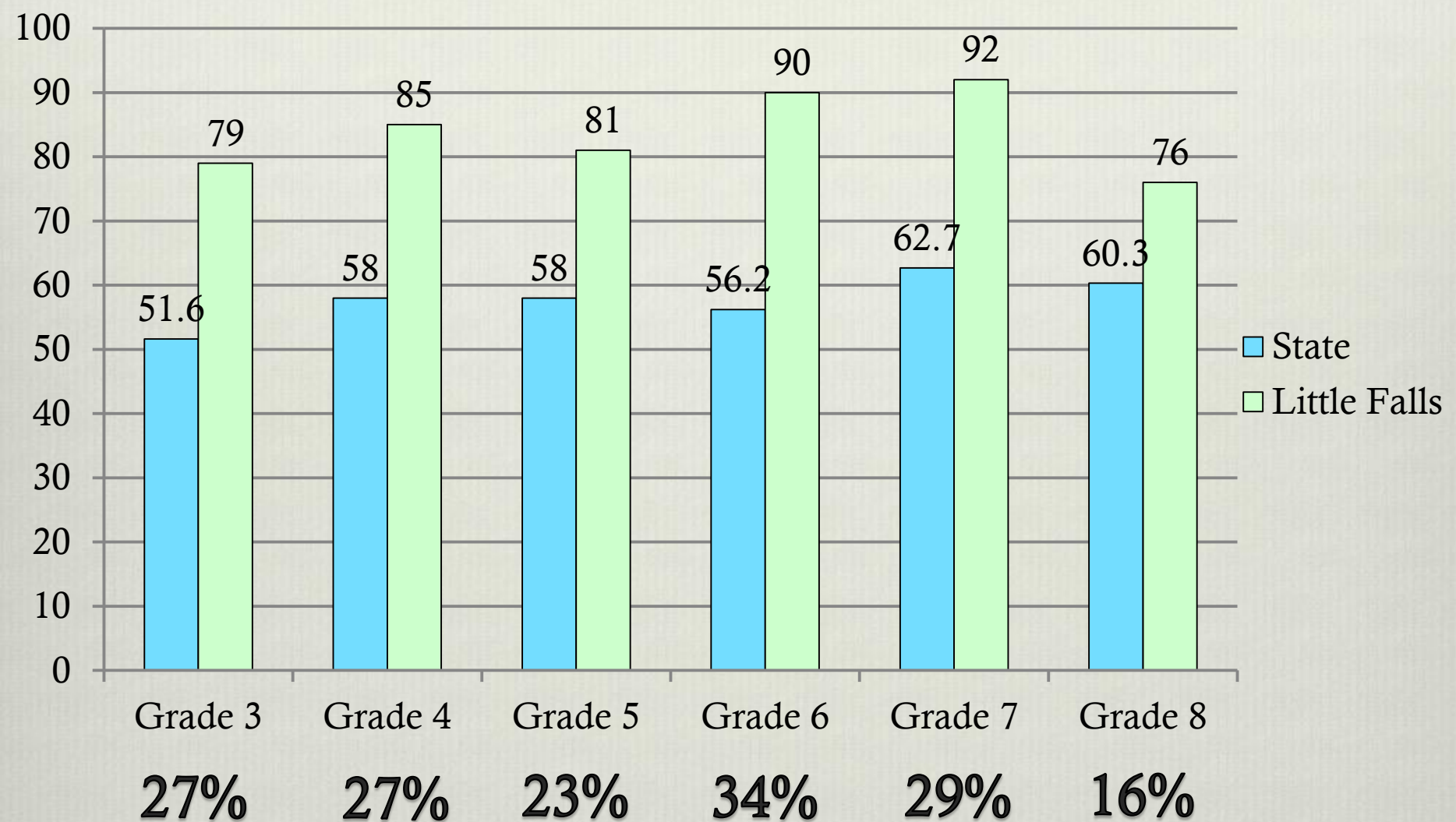
Percentage (%) of students meeting and exceeding standards

Little falls township public schools to new jersey



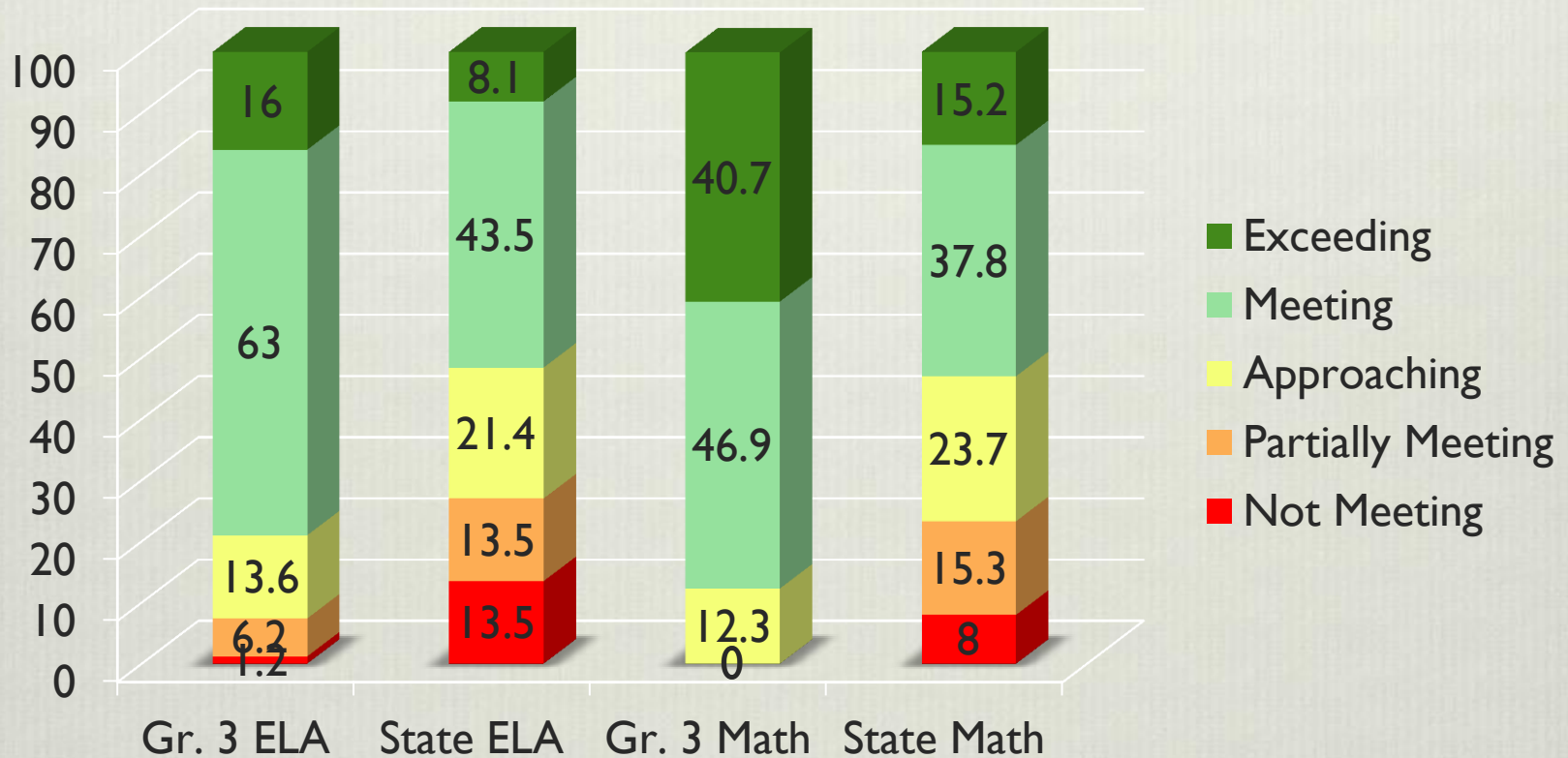
# ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS COMPARISON

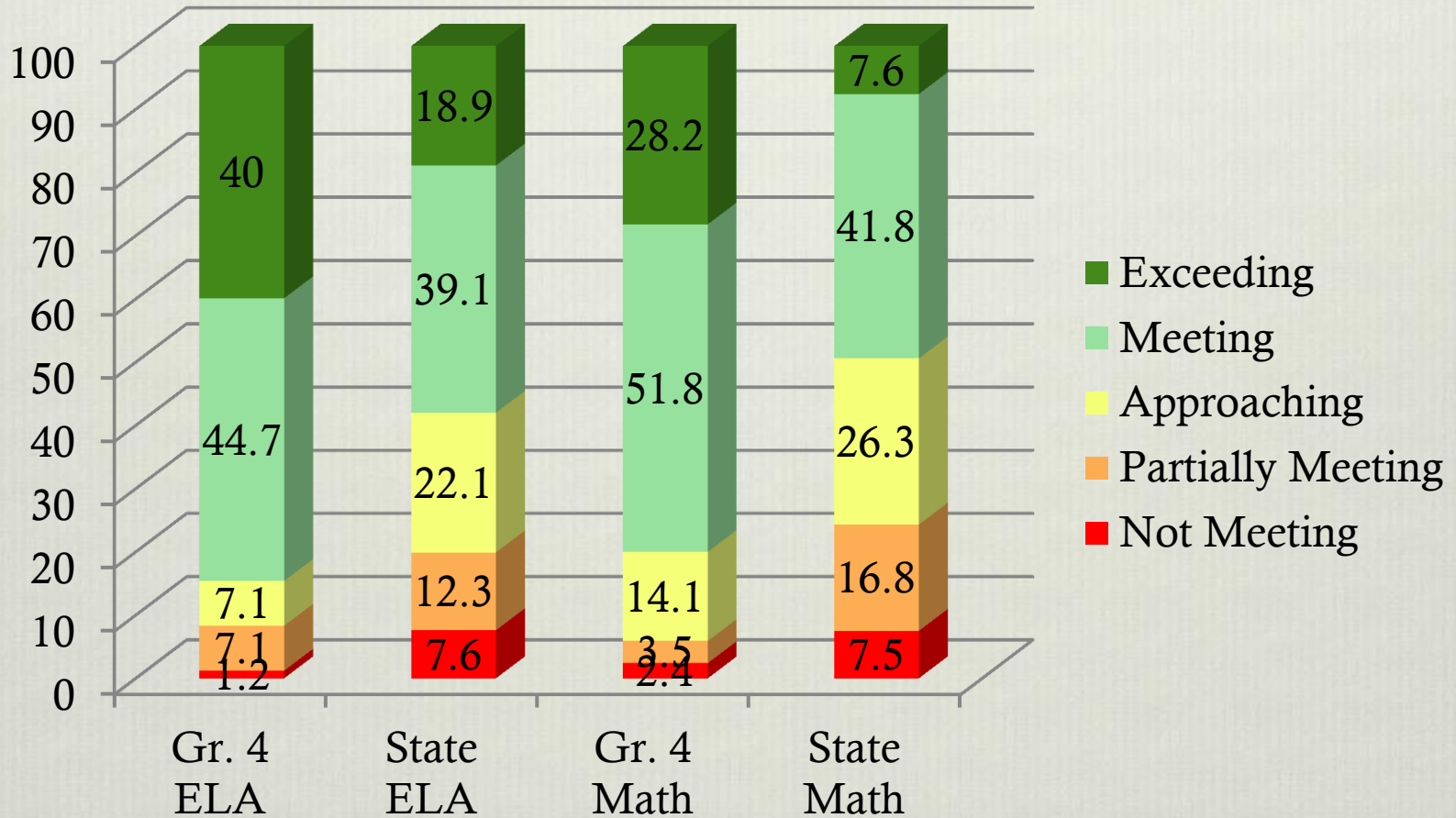

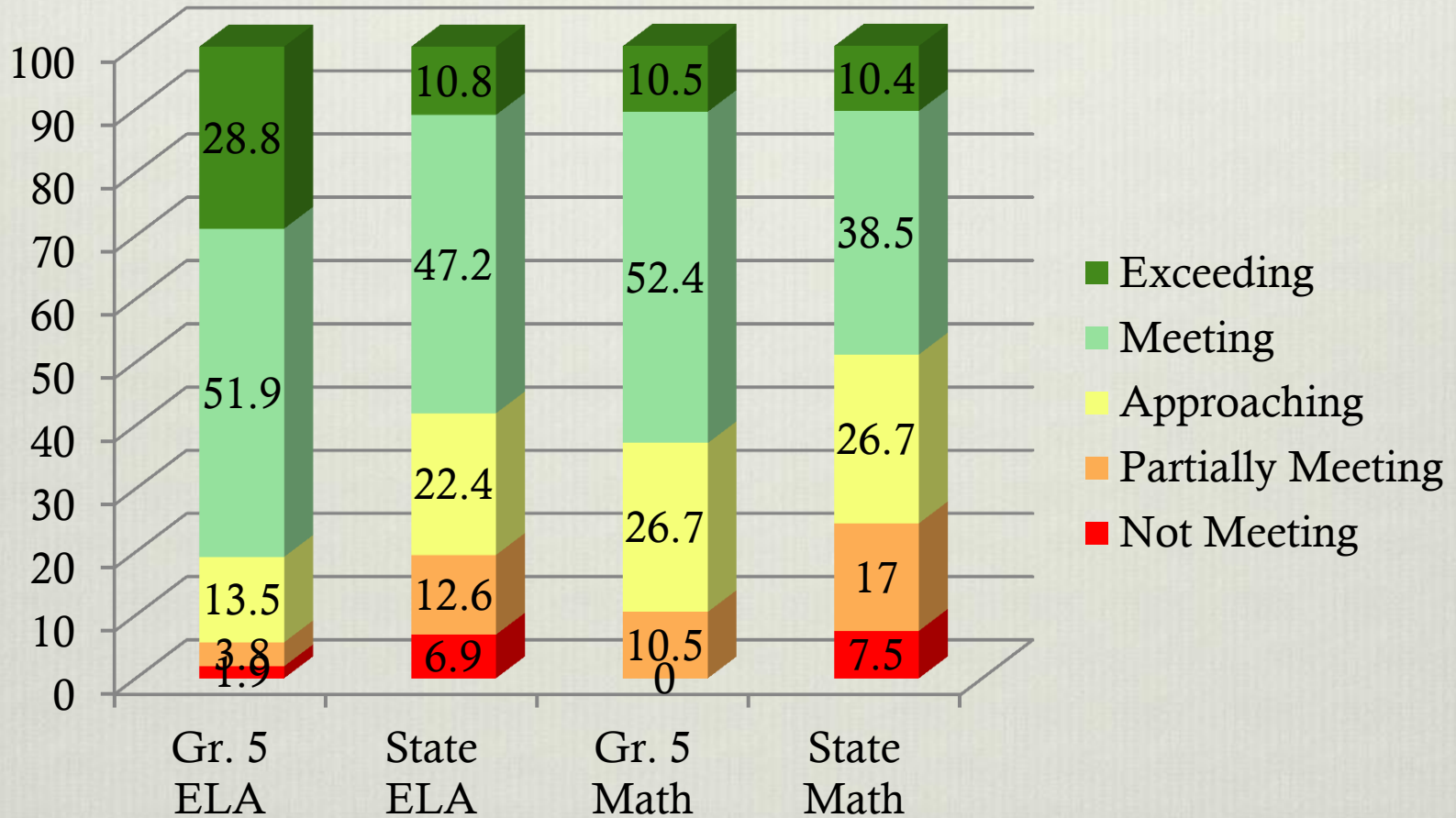

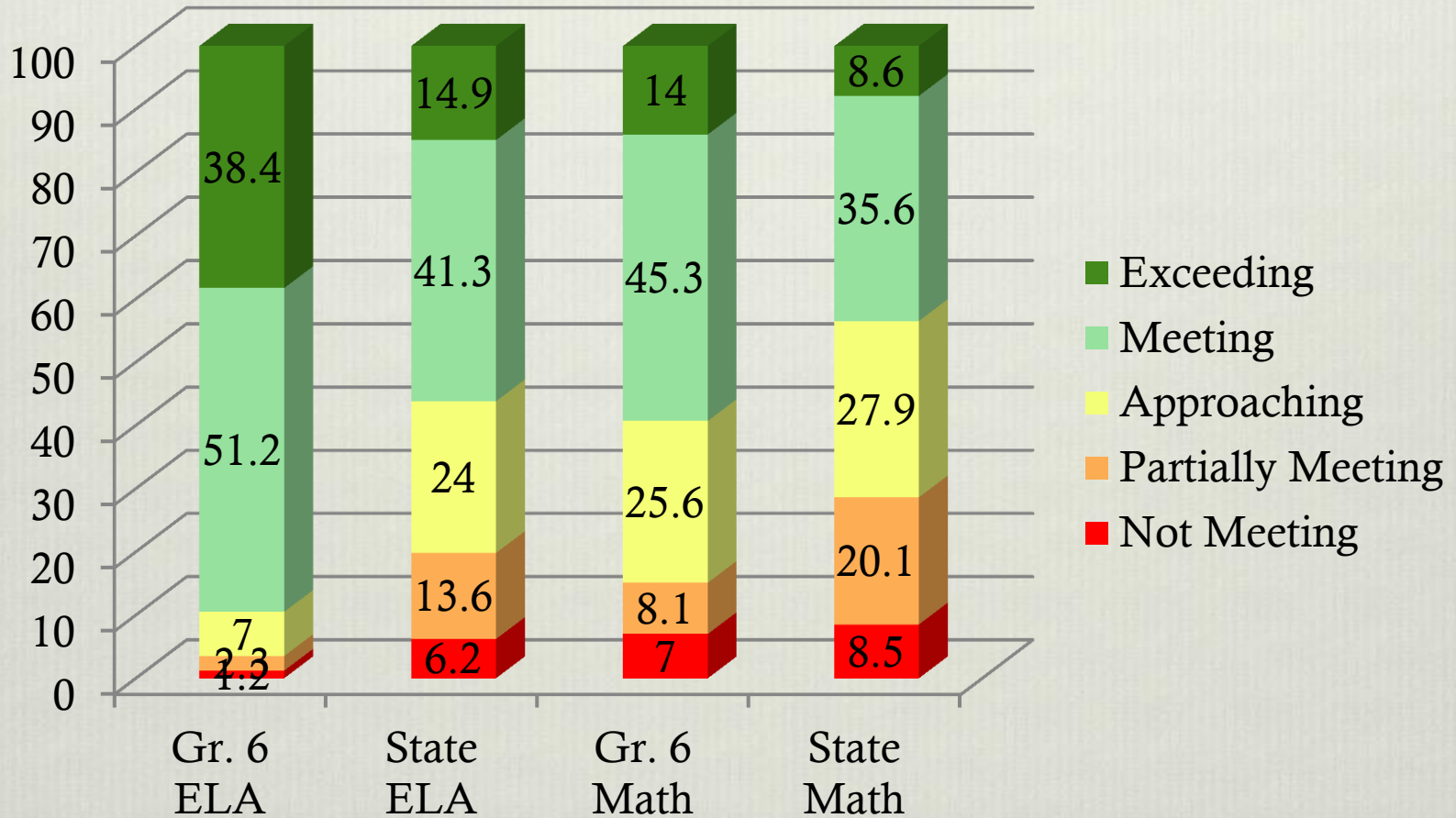

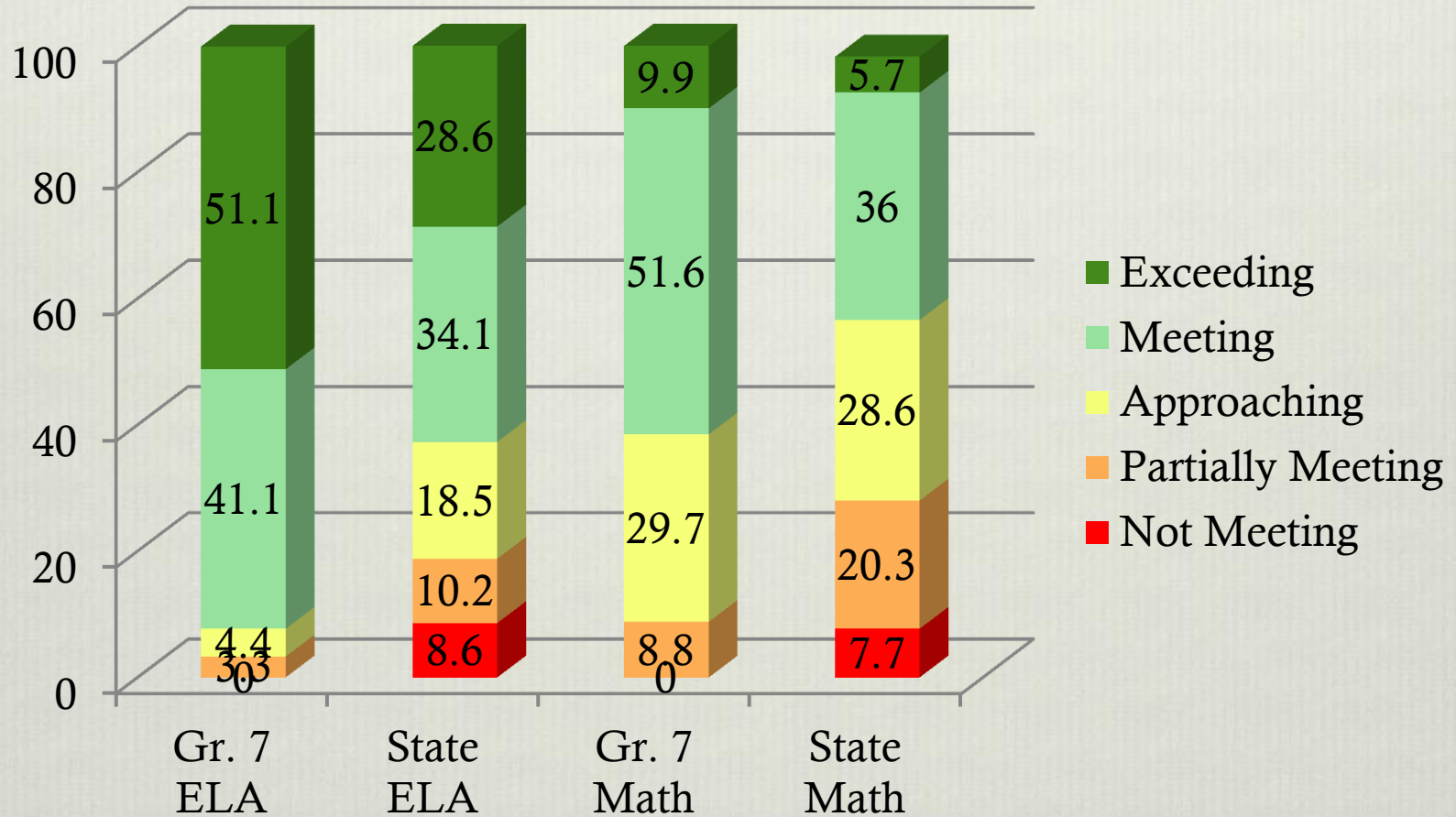

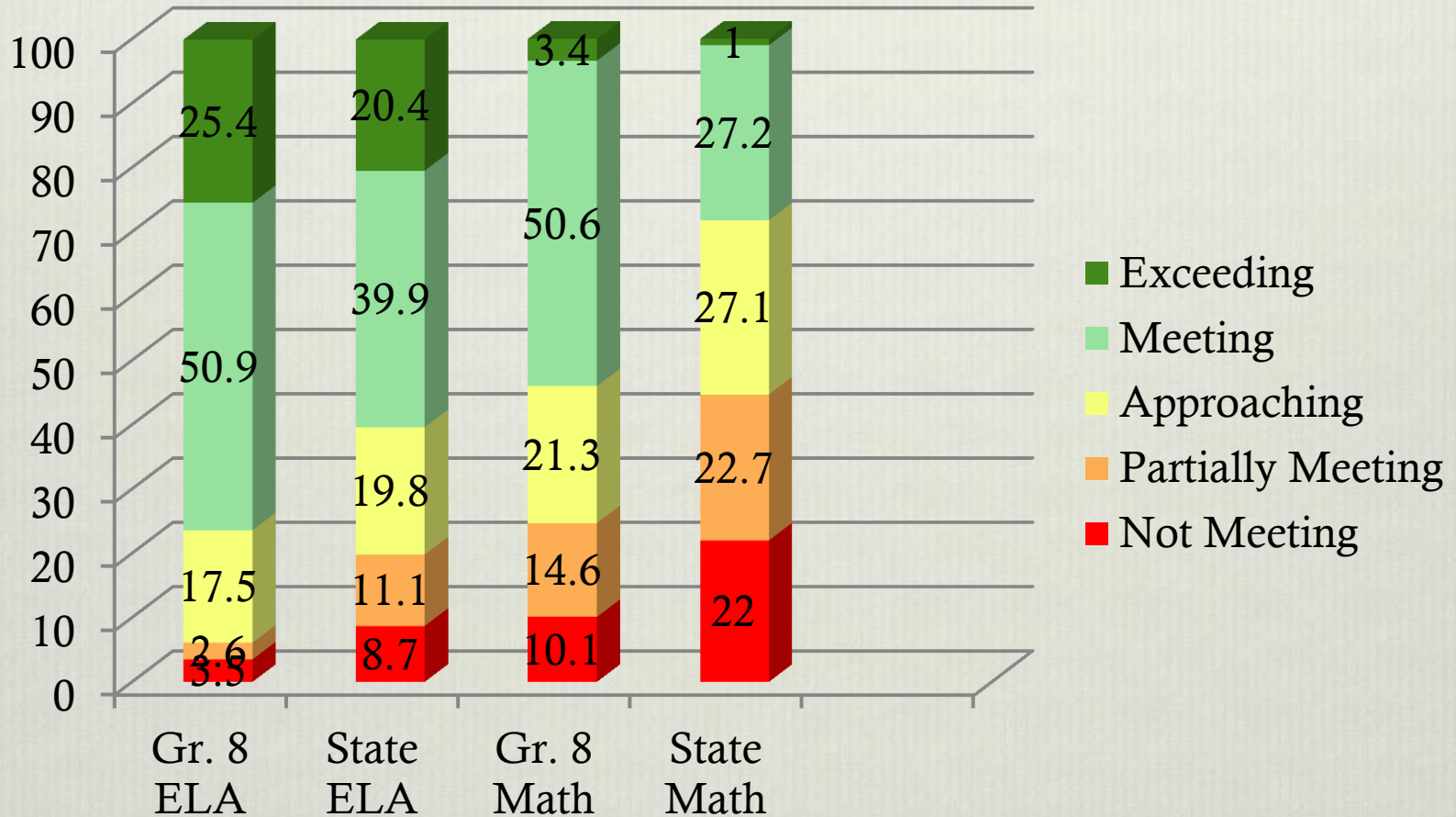

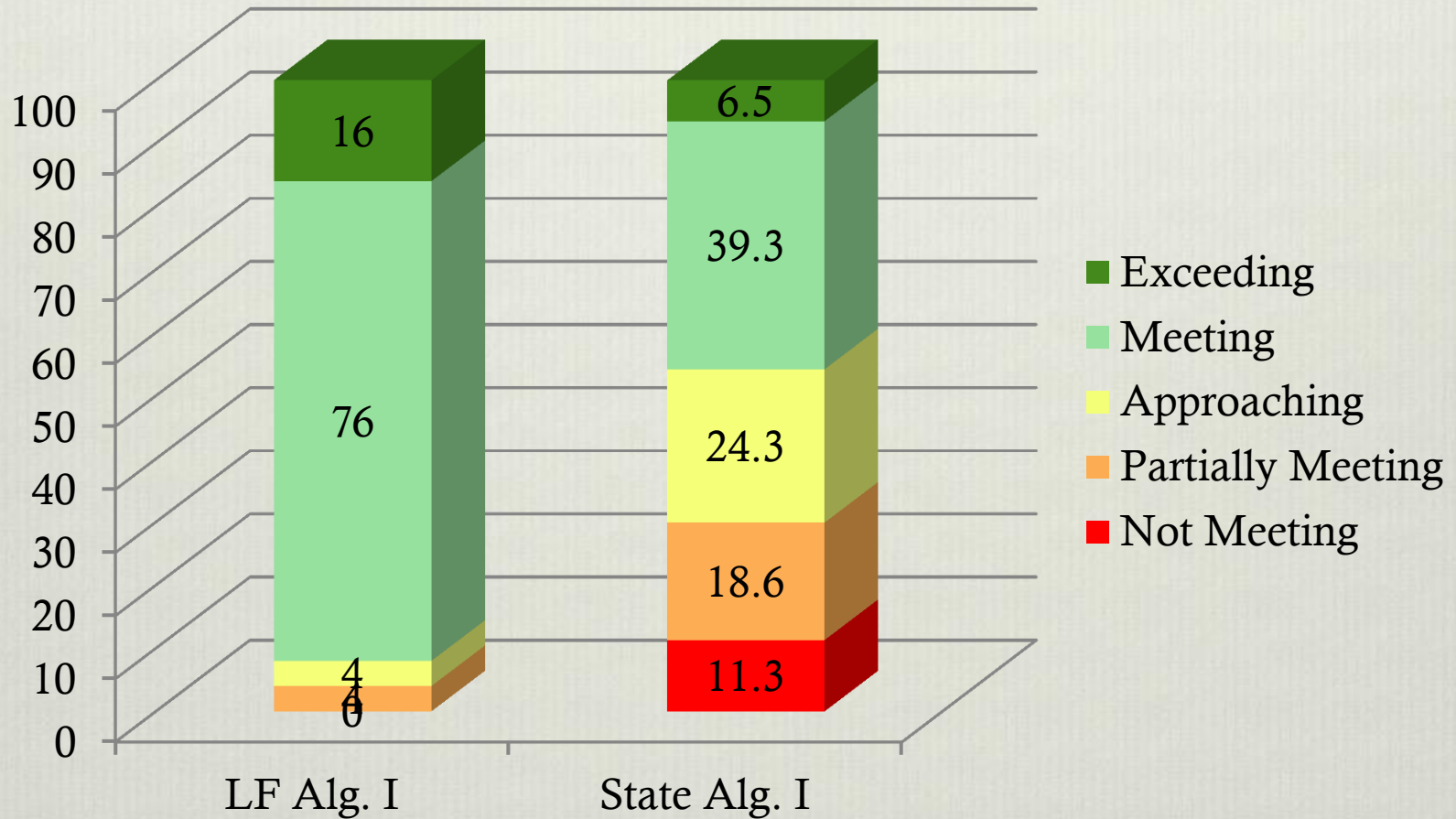

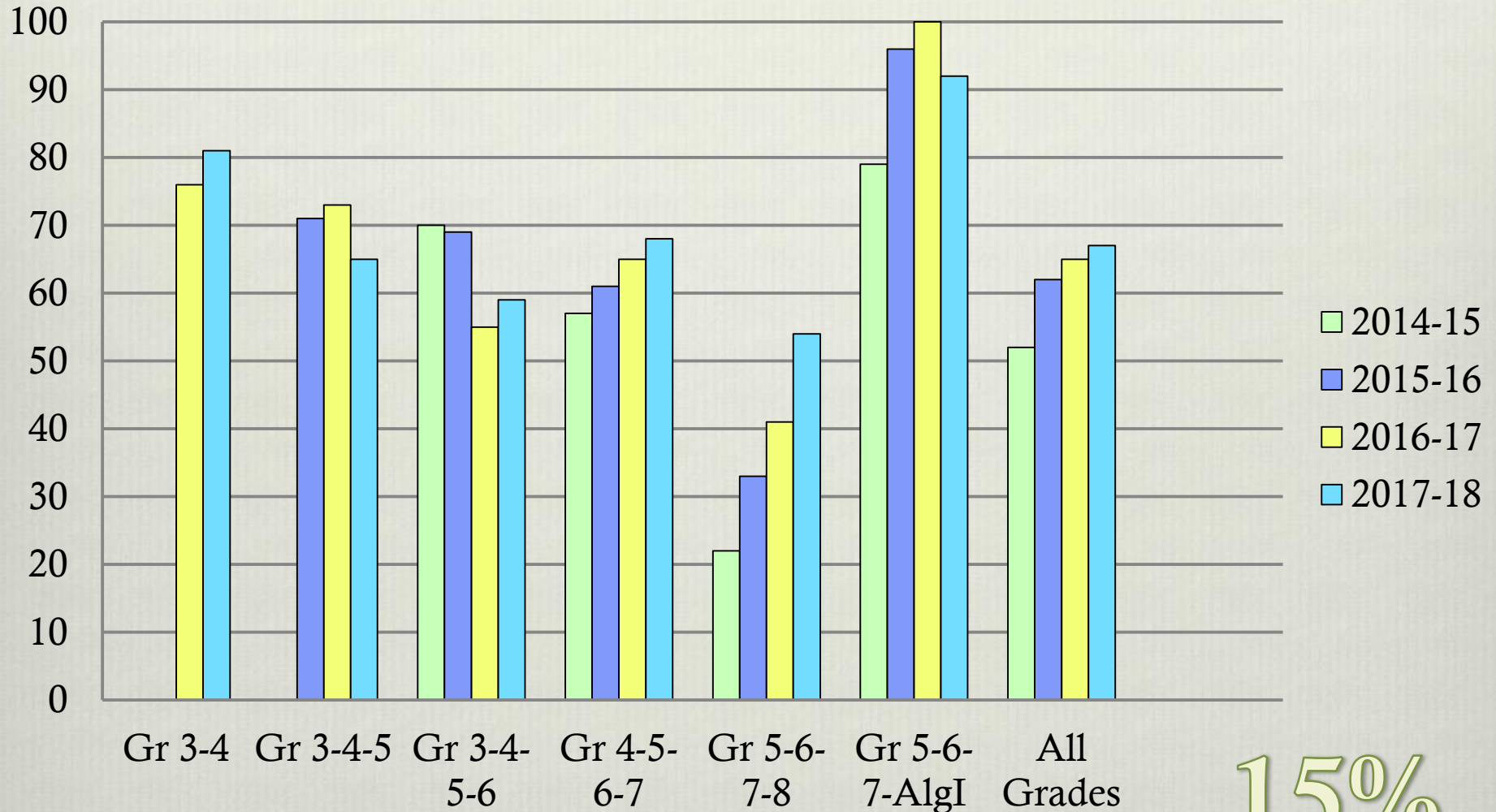

% Meeting + Exceeding

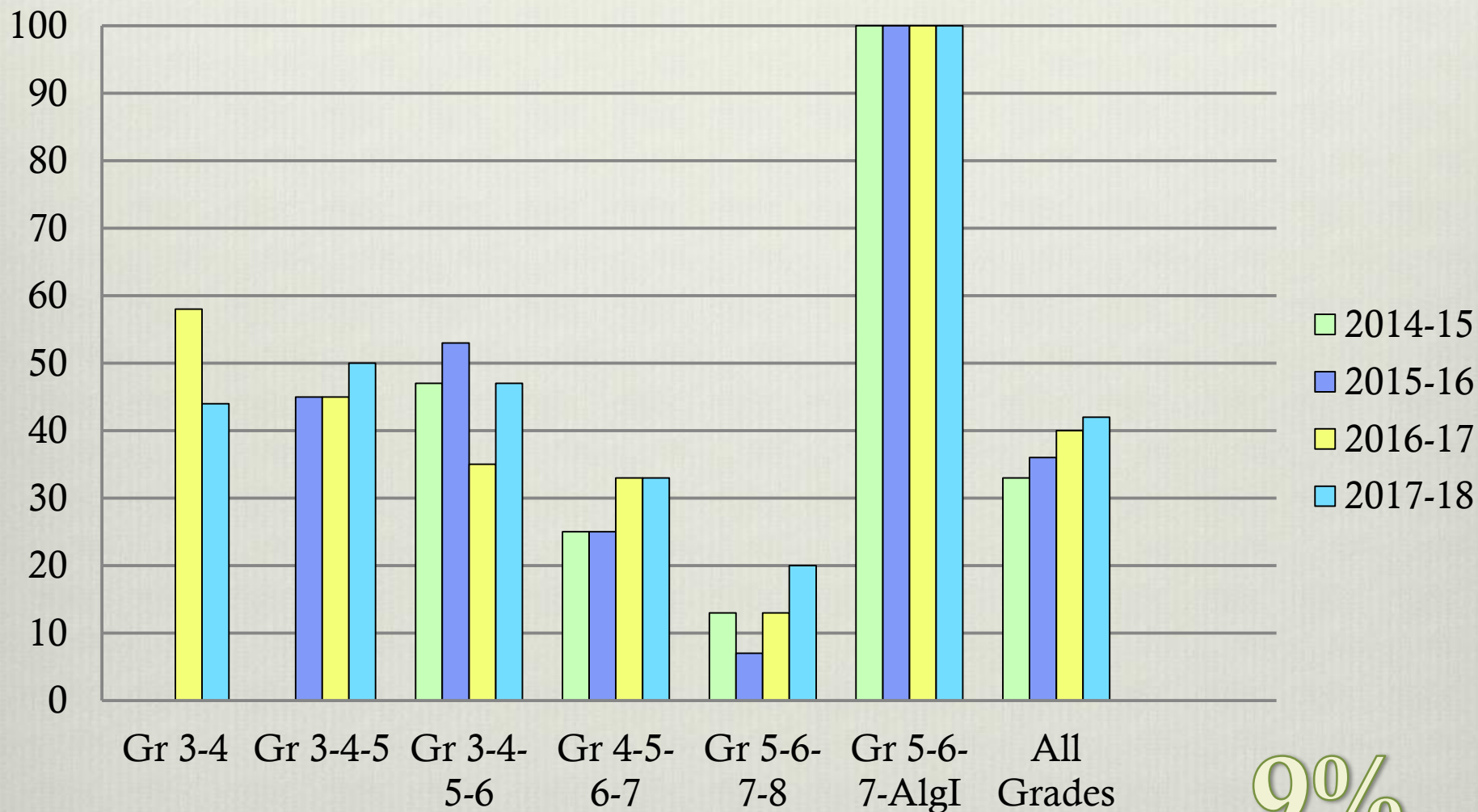

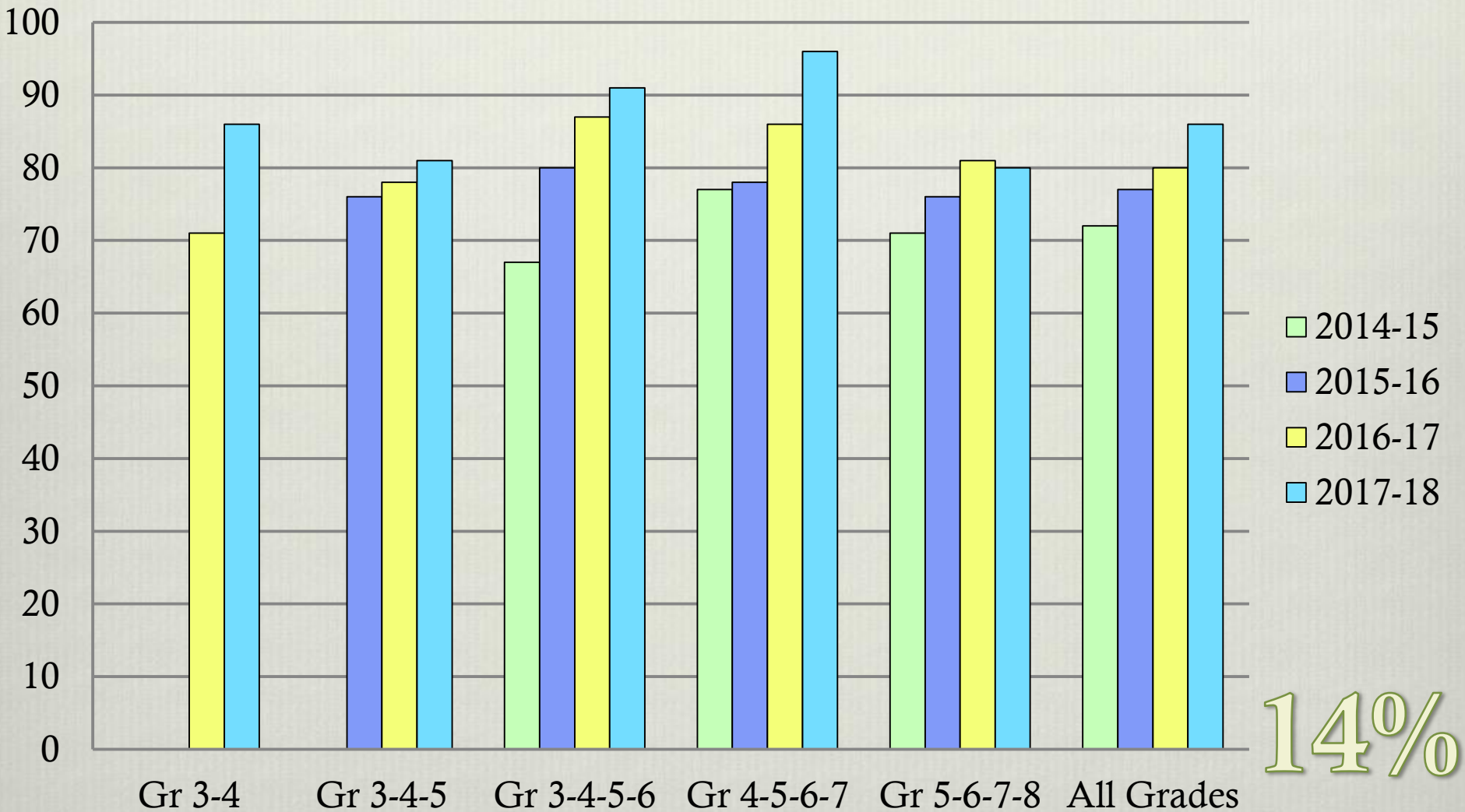
# What changes will be implemented for Mathematics in 2018-19...

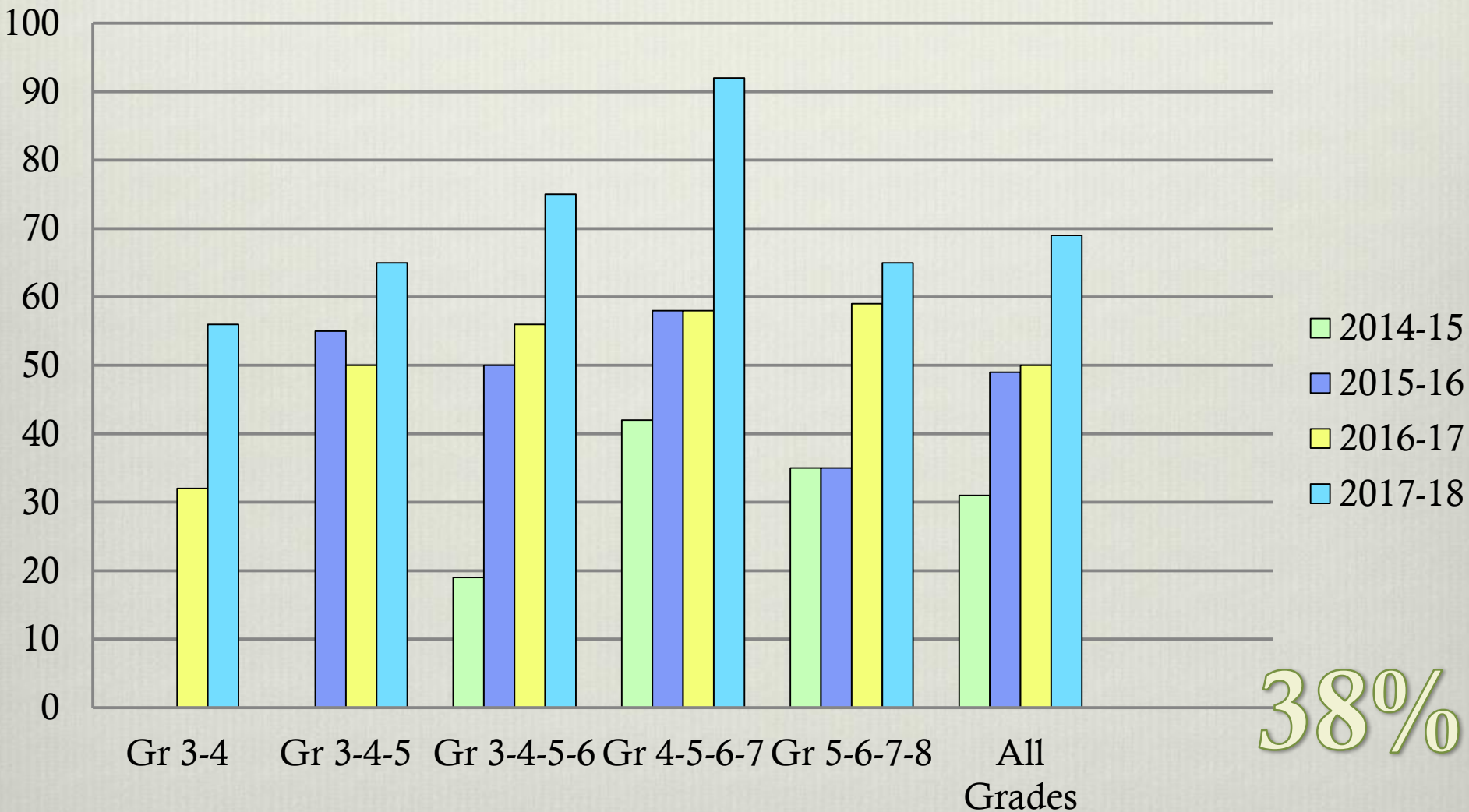
Same students, consecutive grades

# What changes will be implemented for ELA in 2018-19...

- ❖ District review and analysis of evidence statements with staff
- ❖ Staff data binders to be used for PLCs (professional learning communities)
- ❖ PLCs to be held regularly with administration
- ❖ Grade 7 to turnkey vocabulary program at PLCs
- ❖ Fountas and Pinnell in grades 3-8
- ❖ Continue with Orton Gillingham in grades K-2 (3-8 as needed)
- ❖ Summer reading camp to be established
